



# 2011 CANADIAN AIRGUN GRAND PRIX

*Our 29th Year*

The **Canadian Shooting Sports Association** is proud to present its **29th Annual Canadian Airgun Grand Prix**, to be held **January 21, 22 and 23, 2011** at the **Doubletree International Plaza Hotel, 655 Dixon Road, Toronto, Ontario, Canada**. The events for this year's competition will be Air Pistol, Air Rifle, and Pony Club Tetrathlon/Pentathlon. Several seminars and a laser fun event will also be offered this year, details to be announced later.

The Doubletree International Plaza Hotel is located on the airport strip in Etobicoke (Toronto) at 655 Dixon Road. All activities will take place in the hotel. You should make your hotel reservations by **December 31, 2010** to ensure that you obtain a room at the Grand Prix rate. Room rates for this competition are \$123 per night, single or double, \$143 per night triple, parking extra. Be sure to identify yourself as a Grand Prix competitor when reserving your rooms. The Doubletree International Plaza Hotel can be contacted at **1-800-668-3656** or **416-244-1711**, fax **416-244-8031**. There is a free shuttle bus service to and from the airport. Also featured are two water slides, a pool, three hot tubs, exercise facilities, and a number of lounges and restaurants. There are a limited number of wheelchair accessible rooms. If you require one, be sure to indicate this when you reserve. It is suggested you bring a cart for transporting your equipment.

Early registration for the competition will also increase your chances of getting the squadding you desire. The shooting range features 79 positions for air rifle and air pistol, with electric target carriers on all positions. Of the 79 positions, 4 are designed for disabled access. There will also be a 6-position Pony Club range.

The Air Pistol and Air Rifle events will be run in accordance with ISSF rules wherever possible. International Juniors and Sub-juniors may move up in category, but may shoot in one category only. International Juniors and Sub-juniors choosing to shoot in the Senior event must pay the Senior registration fee rather than the Junior fee. Air Pistol and Air Rifle competitors will shoot 2 complete courses of fire. The top 8 in the Men's and the top 8 in the Women's events (including International Juniors and Sub-juniors) will then compete in a 10-shot final to determine the "Open" winners.

The Disabled Rifle match will consist of a 120-shot aggregate of 60 shots standing and 60 shots prone. The Disabled Pistol competition is 120 shots.

The Canadian Airgun Grand Prix is the largest international airgun competition in North America, so join in on the excitement at one of the greatest airgun competitions anywhere. We expect several countries to attend and we have a limit of 300 competitors in the Air Pistol and Air Rifle events.

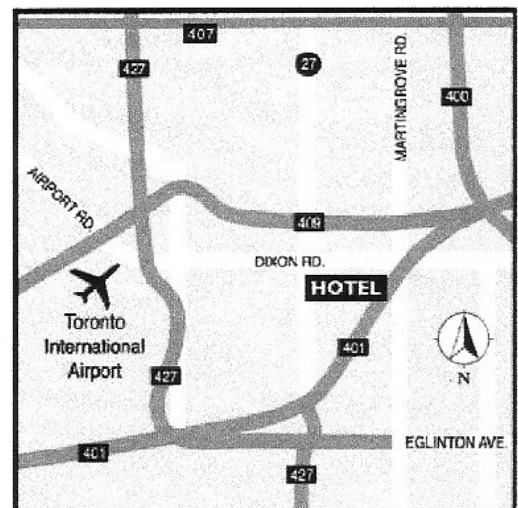
