



2013 CANADIAN AIRGUN GRAND PRIX

The **Canadian Airgun Grand Prix Committee** is proud to present its **31st Annual Canadian Airgun Grand Prix**, to be held **February 15, 16 and 17, 2013** at the **Doubletree International Plaza Hotel, 655 Dixon Road, Toronto, Ontario, Canada**. The events for this year's competition are Air Pistol, Air Rifle, Pony Club Tetrathlon/Pentathlon, and Cadets. Athlete clinics will also be offered.

The Doubletree International Plaza Hotel is located on the airport strip in Etobicoke (Toronto) at 655 Dixon Road. All activities will take place in the hotel. You should make your hotel reservations by **January 25, 2013** to ensure that you obtain a room at the hotel. The room rates being offered by the hotel for this competition are: \$119.00 single, with Premium King Guestrooms \$15.00 additional, and Premium Club Level Guestrooms \$30.00 additional, and we would note that hotel parking for both hotel guests and spectators is an additional fee. Be sure to identify yourself as a Grand Prix competitor when reserving your rooms. The Doubletree International Plaza Hotel can be contacted at **1-800-668-3656** or **416-244-1711** (fax 416-244-7281). There is a free shuttle bus service to and from Toronto Pearson airport. The hotel facilities include a pool with hot tubs and water slides, a spa, exercise facilities, and a number of lounges and restaurants on site and within walking distance of the facility. The hotel and event venue are both accessible facilities but please be advised that there are a limited number of wheelchair accessible rooms so please be sure to indicate any accessibility needs when making your reservation. It is suggested you bring a cart for transporting your equipment.

Please register early for the competition to increase your chances of getting the squadding you desire. The shooting range for this event features 71 positions for air rifle and air pistol, 4 of which are designated solely for disabled access, with electric target carriers on all positions. There will also be a Cadet prone range and a separate Cadet 6-position standing range.

The Air Pistol and Air Rifle events will be run in accordance with ISSF rules wherever possible. International Juniors and Sub-juniors may move up in class category, but may compete in one category only (either by age or by class but not both). International Juniors and Sub-juniors choosing to shoot in the class event must pay the Senior registration fee rather than the Junior fee. Air Pistol and Air Rifle competitors will shoot 2 complete courses of fire (with the exception of the Pony Club category which will only shoot one 40-shot course of fire). The overall top 8 in the Men's and the top 8 in the Women's events (including International Juniors and Sub-juniors) will then compete in a 10-shot Final to determine the "Open" winners. The Finals will follow the previous format, not the format being introduced by the ISSF on January 1, 2013.

The Disabled Rifle match will consist of a 120-shot aggregate of 60 shots standing and 60 shots prone. The Disabled Pistol competition is 120 shots.

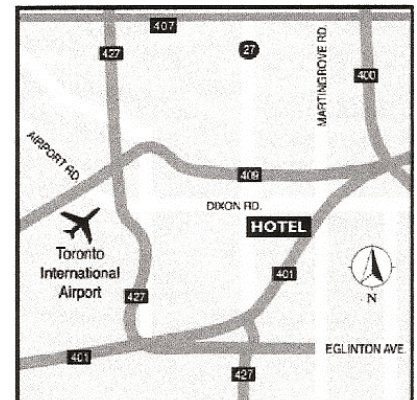
